Computer Account Fees, Rules, and Policies

(This is side 2. Please see other side for application form.)

The following are the department's rules regarding usage and fees for computer accounts.

- "No one shall be expected to pay computer fees from their own pocket. For faculty without a source of support and for graduate students, the fees below will be considered to be part of the department's contribution towards running the computer facilities. Note that these fees are subject to change." The information below is for the rates as of July 1, 2006. See <http://www.math.toronto.edu/admin/fees.html> for more information.

Faculty:

\$1000/year + printing at \$0.10/page

Can arrange accounts for visitors and postdocs at \$250/year + printing at \$0.10/page

Graduate students with advisor:

Yearly account fee (\$50) covered by department

Printing (if approved by advisor) charged to advisor at \$0.10/page

Graduate students without advisor:

Yearly account fee (\$50) covered by department

Printing (within reason) covered by department

- "If abnormally large use of a resource (e.g., disk space) by one user is creating difficulties for other users, the situation will be discussed with those concerned. In particular, excessive printing from accounts paid for by the department will not be tolerated."
- Use of computer accounts is also subject to compliance with the department's "Acceptable Usage Policies" (which currently includes the University's "Appropriate Use of Information Technology" policies) which can be found at
